Objectives The course of private law of sport has as its subject the fundamental principles regulating

Italian private law of sport, whit particular reference to the sporting system.

The course aims at providing the students, through the examination of the relevant legislation and

the most significant case law and commentaries of this matter, with knowledge of the issues inherent

to the sporting system, the personswhich are part of it, the contractual framework, the civil liability

in relation to sport activity.

The course will particularly focus on the examination of the relevant employment contract and the

principles of the civil liability applicable to the world of sport, also with reference to the civil liability

of the doctor and to doping. The course also aims at providing the students with the basic principles

regulating the functioning of the sporting system jurisdiction
