Objectives

The course aims to describe the foundations of general pedagogy and the development of educational-training models. Different areas related to sport will be treated from several point of view: historical, educational, integration and wellness.

TEACHING METHOD

The course is structured in 30 hours of frontal teaching, divided into 2 or 4 hours lessons according to the academic calendar. The frontal teaching includes theoretical lessons and supplementary teaching on the topics covered.

EXAM METHOD

Students' preparation will be verified by assessing a written project prepared by the students and exposed orally by the students on the day of the exam.

The presentation, in power point or similar format, will focus on one of the topics covered in the classroom and the student will proceed with the following scheme:

- Presentation of the chosen topic,
- Development of the topic and its theses
- Understanding and deepening of the topic
- Historiography and sources used
- Conclusions

Through his presentation, the student will demonstrate that he has understood the topic, that he has analyzed it in all its facets from different points of view and that he has drawn personal and professional considerations from it. The exam mark, out of thirty, will also take into account the student's participation in the workshops and classroom lessons.

Other activities

In addition to the teaching activity, the student will be given the opportunity to participate in seminars.
